Often teams bring their families as well which will contribute to additional tourist numbers.

We've used all available traditional, outdoor and social media outlets to promote the CSFL/Pro Bass Tour tournament in Gananoque in advance and will continue during the event. In addition to social media promotions this event we have promoted through radio and print ads. We have also invited writers from Outdoor Canada and Ontario Out of Doors along with local media outlets to come out to the event and write articles surrounding the event, community and anglers.
Has this event been hosted before? If yes, when and where?	The 1000 Islands Cup is an annual event within the Pro Bass Tour Cup Series. The series consists of 4 events: Kawartha Cup, Bronzeback Cup, Quinte Cup and 1000 Islands Cup. The Cup Series was created in 2015.
