# **TAP Application for King Street Productions**

First Peoples' Performing Arts Festival - 2022

### WE'RE STILL HERE

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

We are submitting this application at the suggestion of Mayor Ted Lojko. The First People's Performing Arts Festival is organized and managed by the First Peoples' Circle of the Thousand Islands and works under the umbrella structure of King Street Productions which is an incorporated Non-Profit Arts Organization under a Federal Charter.

This year the Festival is presented from September 23 to 25<sup>th</sup> 2022 under the theme of *Were Are Still Here*. The festival is growing each year including the past two years in spite of COVID. Combined with some outdoors activities celebrating the Great Sacred river, and the ability to provide many events through live-streaming to the greater communities we were able to continue through the two years of health restrictions.

This year we were privileged to receive a grant for the Festival from the Department of Canadian Heritage which has allowed us to engage the renowned musical duo Twin Flames, an award-winning Indigenous group which has garnered many awards including the Canadian Folk Music Awards this year. It has also allowed us to engage the Ollin Drum Circle which is a highly respected drumming group from Kingston that features the story-telling techniques of the drums as well as including the revered Grandfather Drum which is used on special occasions to celebrate the history and contribution of the Indigenous peoples to our land.

Also, there will also be many Indigenous leaders and story-tellers, as well as dancers and other musicians to add to the festivities all weekend long. There will be a Makers Indigenous Craft Market which will feature the intricate artistic work created by these artists. An Indigenous film will be shown on Friday evening, Hosted by renowned Mohawk film and television actress Brittany Lebourgne. The outline of the weekend is listed below.

The success of this Festival is such that we have also received sponsorships from the community as well as enthusiastic participation from the Indigenous communities from Quebec to southern Ontario. The community of Gananoque has also become very supportive of this street East, 75 Kin9 Street 6168



Festival and last year the First People's Park of the Thousand Islands on the Sacred River front of the St. Lawrence was officially dedicated and named in the presence of Indigenous and allied members of the First Peoples' Community. Many non-Indigenous community members attend the various events and have told us how much they appreciate the story-telling and the ceremonial events that they learn about and participate in. Tourists are often attracted to participate in these events as well as they are docked in the marina area.

Advertising for this event has already been started and the actual poster is attached as an example of what is being sent out. This poster is adjusted and updated as new artists are engaged and new sponsors are found. It is distributed through several Facebook on-line groups as well as Instagram and others. There are also hard copies postered throughout Gananoque as well as in Kingston and other communities in the surrounding areas.

It is to be noted that all participants in the programmes will be paid and all participants attending the events will be attending free of charge.

# Contingent Loss of Income Endorsement – Contributing, Recipient, Neighbouring Schedule

This Endorsement Changes the Policy. Please Read It Carefully.

Certain words and phrases in bold font or quotation marks have special meaning as defined below or in the form to which this Endorsement is attached.

The titles of sections or paragraphs listed below should not be considered for purposes of interpreting the intent of this Form; these titles have only been inserted for ease of reading.

This Endorsement modifies insurance provided under the Business Interruption form to which it is attached and is subject to all terms, conditions, limitations and exclusions of such applicable Form.

1.Indemnity Agreement

A. Contributing/Recipient Property

This Form is extended to cover loss of business income resulting from the necessary interruption of or interference with the business of the Insured caused by direct physical loss or direct physical damage by an insured peril occurring during the term of the policy to property situated:

1.1. at the premises of a recipient property, being property to which the Insured's products are being shipped, which wholly or partially prevents the acceptance of products produced or sold by the Insured; or

1.2. at the premises of a contributing property, being a supplier(s) of materials to the Insured, which wholly or partially prevents the delivery of materials to the Insured, excluding:

1.2.1. public utility suppliers such as electricity or gas; or

1.2.2. cable, satellite or other communications suppliers;

1.3. at the premises of the provider of internet access services to the Insured, which wholly prevents the transmission of data.

B. Neighbouring premises

This Form is extended to cover loss of business income resulting from interruption of or interference with the business in consequence of direct physical loss or direct physical damage by an insured peril to property on the same premises, or in neighbouring premises to the Insured, that prevents or hinders the use of or access to the premises or property of the Insured, whether the Insured's premises or property are damaged or not.

This endorsement applies only to properties or premises situated in Canada or in the United States of America and are scheduled under 2 - Limit of Insurance.

2.Limit of Insurance
