	<p>Approve Committee of the Whole report UTIL-2017-03 – Private Lead Water Service Interest Free Loan Program</p> <p>Be it resolved, as recommended by the Committee of the Whole, that the Council of the Town of Gananoque hereby, as part of the Town’s overall program to reduce lead in Municipal drinking water, approves a private lead water service line replacement interest free loan program to further reduce health risks through encouraging homeowners to replace their lead water service lines and to ensure compliance with the lead reduction requirements;</p> <p>And Further, that the Lead Water Service Replacement Interest Free Loan Program be funded through water reserves and repayment of the loan will be made through taxes as set out in the agreement signed by the owner(s). The minimum payment must equal the amount of the loan over the five (5) year term of the agreement (i.e. For a \$2000 loan, the minimum annual payment would be \$400/year). Interest will not be added if the annual loan amount is paid by the due dates of the annual final tax bill, as presented in Committee of the Whole report UTIL-2017-03.</p>

	<p>RESOLUTION No. 2017-057 Moved by: Councillor Warren Seconded by: Councillor Fletcher Whereas the 400 series of highways travels north of the Town of Gananoque, neighbouring Townships within Leeds and Grenville;</p> <p>Whereas there is an ever-growing amount of truck traffic that travels on these highways. There is also an ever-increasing amount of dangerous goods that are transported on those trucks;</p> <p>Whereas it has been identified that high rates of speed during inclement weather events have contributed to accidents in our region including the recent accident that resulted in a chemical spill;</p> <p>Whereas a policy of speed reduction during severe storms has been successfully deployed in other North American jurisdictions and has reduced traffic incidents.</p> <p>Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Gananoque hereby ask the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario look at measures to reduce speed and enforce these speed reductions on 400 series highways when severe storm conditions exist.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">CARRIED - UNANIMOUS</p>
