Gananoque – Mayor Erika Demchuk will join over 1,500 municipal leaders and the Eastern Ontario Mayors Caucus (EOMC) at the Association of Municipalities of Ontario's (AMO) 2016 Conference in Windsor from August 14 to 17.

As part of the Eastern Ontario Mayors' Committee (EOMC), Mayor Demchuk will be participating in meetings with provincial leaders to advocate for important regional priorities in Eastern Ontario.

“The AMO conference is a great opportunity for us to work together to advance our strategic priorities in Eastern Ontario with government ministers and leaders of the opposition,” said Mayor Demchuk. “This year EOMC will be advocating for a change to the current interest arbitration system, continuation of the Eastern Ontario Development Fund and to get more insight into infrastructure programs available to us.”

The annual AMO conference is a chance for municipal officials to work together to address shared challenges and opportunities. In addition to the conference program, Mayor Demchuk will also take part in a number of meetings, plenary sessions and keynote speeches.

This year EOMC has confirmed delegations with several government ministers and the leaders of the opposition. EOMC will also meet and work collaboratively with the Eastern Ontario Wardens' Caucus to represent a united Eastern Ontario front during the conference.

The annual AMO conference is Ontario's largest municipal conference bringing together municipal and provincial leaders to explore municipal challenges and work collectively for the future. Ontario's Premier, the Presidents of AMO and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) and both opposition leaders are all featured speakers.
