

# Water & Wastewater System 2020 Fact Sheet

Since the system was established in 1903 the Town of Gananoque has invested a total of **\$47,211,819** in assets to build the Municipal Drinking Water & Wastewater Systems. This equates to **\$18,507** per household.

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2020 cost to operate the Gananoque Water and Wastewater System **\$1,762,972 = \$691.09** per household . In 2020 Gananoque will invest **\$5,008,765 = \$1,963.45** per household in Capital Replacement Projects

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2021 – 2030  
Town of Gananoque Water & Wastewater Capital  
Needs total **\$38,800,000**  
**\$1,520.97** per year per household for 10 years



The average household will pay **\$3.40** per day for water by comparison, case of 24, 500ml bottled water, costs **\$2.49**

February 2021 - Gananoque must apply for a 5 year renewal to obtain a license to provide municipal drinking water

The application must include a 5 year financial plan which demonstrates that the Water System is financially sustainable

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# Quality Management System Policy
