

FIBRES - Blue Box Recyclables



Items that ARE ACCEPTED in your FIBRES Blue Box



- √ Newspapers, flyers (glossy or plain)
- ✓ Magazines, catalogues, telephone books, greeting cards
- ✓ Fine paper (i.e. writing, computer, envelopes, mail)
- ✓ Paper bags potato bags, flour bags, sugar bags
- ✓ Boxboard cereal, cracker & cookie boxes, shoe & tissue boxes, file folders, laundry cartons, small boxes (i.e. toothpaste, toiletries, cough syrup, medicine, cosmetic), paper egg cartons, empty toilet & paper towel rolls, pizza boxes, apple baskets, paper cups
- ✓ Cardboard flatten all boxes before placing in the *Blue Box*.

Large boxes must be flattened and can be placed beside or under your Blue Box.

Ensure no loose materials that will blow out and cause litter are placed on top.

Ensure all items are clean



Items that ARE NOT ACCEPTED in your FIBRES Blue Box

- No waxed or coated boxes, no waxed food wrap, no photos
- No cookie bags, no chip bags, no dog food bags
- ✗ No plastic bags or vacuum sealed coffee bags
- ✗ No Styrofoam
- No glass, cans, metal, plastics, ice cream or frozen juice containers
- × No gift wrap
- No used tissue or paper towels

CONTAINERS - Blue Box Recyclables



Items that ARE ACCEPTED in your CONTAINERS Blue Box

- ✓ Glass bottles & jars only (food & beverage)
- ✓ Metal & aluminum food & beverage cans & containers
- ✓ Aluminum pie plates/rigid foil trays & foil
- ✓ Milk & juice cartons
- ✓ Plastic bottles & containers only plastics with a recycling symbol ♣ on the bottom, containing the number 1,2,3,4,5 or 6 (eg. pop, juice & water bottles, household detergents, home cleaning & laundry products, windshield washer, vinegar, shampoo & lotion bottles, margarine,
- ✓ Milk bags, frozen food bags (clear), bread bags, mattress bags, paper towel & toilet paper wrap, grocery bags, bulk food bags & diaper packaging. <u>NO DIAPERS</u>
- ✓ **clean** soil, sand, peat moss & fertilizer bags (clear bags only)

Ensure all items are empty and rinsed clean



Items that ARE NOT ACCEPTED in your CONTAINERS Blue Box

- × No motor oil bottles or herbicide/pesticide bottles
- × No light bulbs or ceramic
- × No window glass, dishes, mirrors or clear prescription bottles
- ✗ No chip bags, no straws
- No pots & pans, hard plastic toys or plastic used to insulate windows
- × No paper
- No Styrofoam
- x No Clean empty paint cans or aerosol cans

Recyclables are collected alternate weeks – Fibres (paper and cardboard) one week, while containers (plastic, metal and glass) are collected the alternate week.
