## From Your WASTE & RECYCLING Department

COLLECTION: Please ensure all materials are placed at the curb **NO LATER than 7:00am** on your collection day. Materials set out late will not be collected if you miss the truck.

### Recycling

The Town provides weekly residential curbside blue box recycling collection to all households. Material is collected in alternate weeks, which means that one week is fibres [paper, cardboard, boxboard], while the alternate week is containers [plastics, aluminum/metal and glass [bottles and jars only]]. Ensure that no loose items that will blow away are placed on top of the blue boxes to eliminate wind-blown litter. Blue bags are acceptable for recycling materials. There is not set out limit for the number of bags or containers you can put out per week. Recycling materials do not require a tag.

### Garbage

The Town provides weekly residential curbside garbage collection to all households. This service is for garbage generated in your household on a daily basis. Each household may set up to 4 bags of garbage out per week for collection. Bags must not weigh more than 40lbs. Garbage must be bagged and tagged. Each **bag** must display a valid Town bag tag and be visible to the collector. Please do not affix your tag to your container. Bag tags can be purchased at Home Hardware, Metro, Shoppers Convenience, Town Hall & Whites Grocery. Tags are \$2.50 each and are purchased in books of 10 [tax included]. If your bags are out on time but not collected, the collector will leave a tag stating the reason it was left behind. Large items are not collected at the curb.

The Town does not provide *commercial* curbside collection. All businesses are responsible for the proper disposal of their waste and recycling. Businesses must transport it to a waste company, or utilize a private collector or bin service.

**If your garbage or recycling was not collected, and it was out by 7:00am, please contact Waste Connections at 613-548-4428.**

### Large Item Disposal

Large items/other garbage such as small appliances, furniture, tables, chairs, toys, linens, clothes, mattresses, renovation materials, etc., are not collected at the curb. Large items must be transported and disposed of at a waste disposal business such as Waste Connections or Waste Management in Kingston. Fees will apply. The Town is holding two residential clean up 'dump days' in 2023. Businesses are excluded.

### Residential Clean Up 'Dump Days' - 2023

Residents can dispose of their large items at the Public Works Yard on 'Residential Clean-Up Dump Days' on **Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup> & Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> from 8:00am to 12:00noon**. Fees do apply. Cash only. Site access is via James A. Brennan Rd only.

### Brush, Leaf, Yard Waste Collection – May & November

Spring and fall collection will take place again this year from **May 1<sup>st</sup> to May 19<sup>th</sup>** and again **October 30<sup>th</sup> to November 17<sup>th</sup>**. Residents can place brush, leaf & yard waste at the curb and Staff will collect it. It must be piled neatly at the curb, must NOT impede vehicular/pedestrian traffic; paper bags only (plastic bags will not be collected). Please note the deadlines for placing material at the curb; however, collection will

continue until the end of the month. Please do not place your leaves and yard waste out for collection following the deadlines, as By-Laws will be enforced. Outside of the spring & fall collection service, brush, leaf & yard waste is accepted at the Public Works Yard during regular hours of operation, free of charge.

### **Public Works Yard – Recycling, Brush & Yard Waste Drop Off**

The Public Works Yard is open to residents for the disposal of electronic waste, scrap metal, white bulk styrofoam, brush, leaf & yard waste from residential properties (only). The Site is accessible via the James A. Brennan Rd entrance only. If the gate is closed it means the Site is closed and you will need to return on a day when it is open.

**2023 Hours of Operation: 8:00am-12:00noon**

January to April – the first Wednesday & the last Saturday of each month.

May to November – every Wednesday and every Saturday from 8:00am to 12:00noon. Schedules may be affected by statutory holidays.

### **Household Hazardous Waste Days (HHW)**

### **Full Producer Responsibility – Blue Box – March 31, 2025**

Ontario is making producers responsible for managing the waste generated from their products and packaging to promote innovation, reduce waste and lower costs for taxpayers. This means producers (the companies that design, create and market products and packaging) will be responsible for managing and paying for the full life-cycle of their products to make recycling easier and more accessible across the province. Producer responsibility is the most effective and accountable way to: promote waste diversion; align costs of managing products and packaging at their end-of-life; save taxpayers money; give producers incentive to redesign products and make them easier to recycle. Ontario will continue to ensure that during program transitions to producer responsibility, there will be no disruption to public services. The Town is scheduled to shift to full producer responsibility by March 31, 2025.
