

Paper (Green) Box Recyclables

Ensure that no loose material is on top that will blow out and cause litter.

Items that SHOULD be placed in *Paper Box*



- ✓ Newspaper & flyers (glossy or plain)
- ✓ Popsicle wrappers, paper potato bags, flour bags, sugar bags, paper cups
- ✓ Fine paper (i.e. writing, computer, mail)
- ✓ Boxboard such as cereal, cracker & cookie boxes, detergent/laundry cartons, file folders, shoe & tissue boxes, apple baskets, over the counter drug boxes (i.e. toothpaste, toiletries, cough syrups, medicine and cosmetics), paper egg cartons, toilet & paper towel rolls and pizza boxes
- ✓ Magazines, catalogues, telephone directories & greeting cards
- ✓ Cardboard & corrugate cardboard – flatten all boxes before placing in the *Paper Box*. Large boxes can be flattened and placed beside or under your *Paper Box*.

Items that should NOT be placed in *Paper Box*




- ✗ No plastic bags, plastic tubs or bottles or vacuum sealed coffee bags
- ✗ No cookie bags or dog food bags
- ✗ No styrofoam
- ✗ No waxed or coated boxes, waxed food wrap/boxes & no photos
- ✗ No glass, cans, metal, ice cream or frozen juice containers
- ✗ No gift wrap
- ✗ No used tissue or paper towels

Blue Box Recyclables

Ensure all items are empty and rinsed clean

Items that SHOULD be placed in *Blue Box*



- ✓ Glass food and beverage bottles and jars
- ✓ Metal food & beverage cans
- ✓ Milk & frozen food bags (Clear), bread bags, mattress bags, paper towel & toilet paper wrap, grocery & bulk food bags & diaper packages – **NO DIAPERS**, clean soil, sand, peat moss & fertilizer bags (Clear)
- ✓ **Clean empty paint cans – lids must be off**, aerosol cans,
- ✓ Plastic bottles – only items marked on the bottom with a recycling symbol  containing the numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 (i.e. soft drink, juice & water, LCBO, household detergents, home cleaning & laundry products, windshield washer, vinegar, shampoo & lotion bottles)
- ✓ Aluminum pie plates & foil, rigid foil containers & trays
- ✓ Margarine and yogurt tubes
- ✓ Milk and juice cartons

Items that should NOT be placed in *Blue Box*



- ✗ No motor oil bottles or herbicide/pesticide bottles
- ✗ No light bulbs or ceramic
- ✗ No window glass, dishes, mirrors, or clear prescription bottles
- ✗ No chip bags & straws
- ✗ No pots & pans, hard plastic toys, or plastic used to insulate windows
- ✗ No paper
- ✗ No Styrofoam
