Town Hall Soft Re-opening – Phase I:

On Monday, July 6, 2020 Town Hall will begin opening daily from 10:00am to 2:00pm. The east doors will be used as “entrance only” and the west doors will be used as “exit only”. All doors will be sanitized throughout the day. Each person entering the building must wear a mask and sanitize their hands upon entry. Please follow the signs posted.

Only debit card or cheque payments will be accepted. No cash payments. Should you have payments that can be undertaken online or business that can be conducted over the phone or email we respectfully ask that you continue to do so or sign up for monthly payment plans.

CANCELLED: King Street East Closures on Saturdays:

After careful consideration, the Business Improvement Area (BIA) Board has decided to not close King Street East in July and August on Saturdays.

The Board and Businesses within the BIA area have determined that the closure will not benefit them at this time with the restrictions still in place by the Province for music, animation and the gathering of people. Public Safety is the utmost importance.
