**Gananoque, ON –** The Town of Gananoque is making plans to slowly reopen Town facilities to the Public.

Town Hall - Town Hall will reopen to the public beginning February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 10:00am to 2:00pm Monday to Friday. However, where possible, residents are still encouraged to conduct municipal business over the phone, by email or digital meetings. In-person meetings are discouraged. Should an in-person meeting be required, please arrange a specific date and time with the related staff member. These guidelines are to continue to maximize staff and public safety.
