Guidelines

The Public Works Yard accepts residential **electronic waste**, **scrap metal & white bulk styrofoam recycling**, **as well as brush**, **leaf & yard waste** during specified hours of operation, free of charge.

If the gates are closed the Site is not open. Please do not dump your materials at the gates when the Site is closed, as illegal dumping is a fineable offence

Important: Before bringing scrap metal such as an old fridge, freezer, air conditioner or dehumidifier that contains a refrigerant, the refrigerant/freon must be removed & tagged by a certified professional. Items containing freon will not be accepted. Plastic bags containing yard/leaf waste are not accepted (paper bags only).
