

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BY-LAW NO. 2011-35

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2009-02B, AS AMENDED, BEING A
GENERAL PURPOSE BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH GENERAL FEES AND RATES FOR
VARIOUS SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, a municipality may impose fees and charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

AND WHEREAS Section 398 of the Municipal Act, 2001 allows the municipality to add unpaid fees and charges to the collector's roll for the property and collect in the same manner as taxes;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Part V of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002, as amended, states that the municipality must provide full cost recovery financial plans in accordance with Section 3 and 9 of the Sustainable Water and Sewage Systems Act, 2002 to the Minister for approval;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "K" of By-Law 2009-02B, as amended, be amended to establish the Quarterly Billing Water and Sewer Rates as follows:

5/8"	\$35.02	1.2059037
3/4"	\$42.84	1.2059037
1"	\$54.39	1.2059037
1 1/2"	\$80.83	1.2059037
2"	\$112.13	1.2059037
3"	\$173.26	1.2059037
4"	\$325.98	1.2059037
Outside Area Consumers Charge (in addition to meter size charge)	\$56.32	1.2059037

Other Charges and Fees:

Occupancy Charges	\$25.00
Collection Charge	\$25.00
Late payment charges	5% of current charges
Turning water off/on for summer services	\$75/meter
Turning water off/on for non-payment	\$75

Services connected to the municipal water system but not connected to the municipal sewer system, commonly referred to as 'Water Only Accounts', shall be charged the Basic Charge plus the Rate per Cubic Meter charge times the water consumption.

Sewer Rate shall be charged at the rate of 125% of the water Basic Charge plus the Rate per Cubic Meter charge.

2. That the fees established by this by-law shall come into force and effect on September 1, 2011.
