CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BYLAW NO. 2011-51

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2005-41 AND AMENDING BY-LAW 2006-22, WHICH ARE BY-LAWS TO REGULATE SIGNS AND OTHER ADVERTISING DEVICES IN THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2011, Chapter 25, Section 99, that Councils of Local Municipalities may pass by-law for prohibiting or regulating signs and other advertising devices and the posting of notices on buildings or vacant lots within the municipality;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque deems it appropriate in the public interest to pass a by-law to amend By-law 2005-41.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque hereby enact as follows;

- 1. That By-law 2005-41 is hereby amended by adding the following to Section 4.0 Signs Permitted for All Use Categories:
 - k) Portable Signs (A-Frame/Sandwich Board) for the local Chamber of Commerce and a defined Farmers' Market during operations.
- 2. That Section 7.0 Signs Permitted for Residential Buildings, Sub-Section 7.3 to By-law 2005-41 is hereby repealed and the following substituted:
 - a) Only one (1) ground sign, projecting sign or soffit sign per lot, identifying a Bed and Breakfast or Heritage Tourist Inn, shall be permitted.
 - b) A ground sign shall not exceed a sign height of 2.0m, or a sign area of 1.0 sq.m.
 - c) All other provisions shall comply with Section 6.5, 6.8 and 6.9.
- 3. That this by-law come into force and effect on the date of passing
