

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BY-LAW NO. 2013-012

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SEPARATED TOWN OF GANANOQUE TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED COUNTIES OF LEEDS AND GRENVILLE FOR THE PROVISION OF TIERED EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONSE SERVICES.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001 provides authority for municipalities to pass by-laws to enter into agreements with persons or municipalities for the purpose of receiving fire protection services; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville have established and organized the Leeds Grenville EMS Division to provide ambulance services in Leeds and Grenville as authorized by the Ontario Minister of Health and Long-Term Care; and

WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of The Separated Town of Gananoque deems it expedient to develop a tiered emergency medical response service with the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The Separated Town of Gananoque hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That the Town of Gananoque is hereby authorized to enter into a multi-tiered emergency medical response service agreement as set out in Appendix A attached hereto.
- 2) That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute said agreement.
- 3) That the Fire Chief is hereby authorized to execute Schedule 'B' – Roles and Responsibility Agreement of the Agreement.

READ THREE TIMES and finally passed this 5th day of March, 2013.
