

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BY-LAW 2013-090

---

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYING OF AN ANNUAL ALLOWANCE  
TO THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWN OF GANANOQUE

---

**WHEREAS** under Section 283(1) of the Municipal Act, S.O., 2001, c.25, as amended, a municipality may pay any part of the remuneration and expenses of the members of any local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the local board;

**AND WHEREAS** under Section 9 (1) (a) and (b) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, Section 8 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to enable them to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and to enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** the Town of Gananoque did not revoke the resolution under subsection 255 (2) or (3) of the old Act before January 1, 2003, declaring that one third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of council is deemed as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of the council;

**AND WHEREAS** under Section 283 (5) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, such resolution shall be deemed to be a by-law of the municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque enacts as follows:


1. Effective January 1, 2015, an annual allowance shall be paid to each member of Council of The Corporation of the Town of Gananoque, as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. Effective January 1, 2015, the annual allowance paid to each member of Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque shall be adjusted annually to the cost of living, as established by the Consumer Price Index on the previous October 1<sup>st</sup>.
3. The annual allowance paid to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, and Councillors does not include the remuneration as a Member of the Police Services Board or other Boards and/or Committees upon which the above may be a member. Remuneration for sitting as a Member of the Police Services Board or other Boards and/or Committees shall be paid over and above the annual allowance paid to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, and Councillors.
4. Such allowance shall be paid monthly, and in the event of the death of a member or upon his ceasing to be a member for any reason before the expiration of his or her term of office, the amount payable to him/her or to

his/her personal representative shall be in proportion to the period of his or her service during such term.

5. Effective January 1 2015 annual honorariums shall be paid to each member of Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque designated as a member of a Joint Service Committee, as set out in Schedule 'B' attached hereto.
6. In accordance with Section 283 (5) of the Municipal Act, 2001, that one-third of the amount payable to members of council shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of a members duties and therefore exempt from Income Tax.
7. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing.


