

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BY-LAW NO. 2014-116

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT A MULTI-YEAR ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

WHEREAS by Section 5 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that the powers of every Council are to be exercised by Bylaw; and

WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 191/111 and the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA) requires all public corporations to adopt a Multi-Year Accessibility Plan that provides for a guideline regarding accessibility within their respective community; and

WHEREAS The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) establishes mandatory accessibility standards for public organizations which include specific timelines.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of Town of Gananoque hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That the Multi-Year Accessibility Plan attached hereto as Schedule "A" is hereby adopted;
- 2) That the Plan come into force and effect on the date of passing;

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME this 17th day of November, 2014.




