BY-LAW NO. 2017-052**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH AN ASSISTIVE DEVICES POLICY FOR THE TOWN
OF GANANOQUE.**

AND WHEREAS section 5 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provided that the powers of every Council are to be exercised by By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque enacts as follows:

1. That the Assistive Devices Policy for the Town of Gananoque attached hereto as Schedule 'A' and forming part of this by-law is hereby adopted.
2. That this by-law come into force and effect on the date of passing.
3. That any by-law inconsistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.

POLICY

The Corporation of the Town of Gananoque is committed to providing exceptional customer service to all customers, including those who use assistive devices in order to obtain, use or benefit from our goods and services.

It is the policy of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque to allow people to use their own personal assistive devices, unless otherwise prohibited by law, to access our goods and services.

OBJECTIVE(S)

The objective of this policy are to:

- Ensure people are allowed to use their own assistive devices to access our goods and services,
- Outline all other measures the Town offers to enable people to access our goods and services

PROCEDURES

Use of Personal Assistive Devices

Personal assistive devices are often used by people with disabilities to help them with daily living. They are usually devices that people bring with them.

Personal assistive devices are any auxiliary aids such as communication aids, cognition aids, personal mobility aids and/or medical aids. They may include (but are not limited to):

- Manual and motorized wheelchairs
- Canes, crutches and walkers
- White canes
- Hearing aids
- Magnifiers
- Oxygen tanks
- Electronic communication devices

In order to ensure that persons with disabilities are allowed to use their own personal assistive devices, employees of the Town of Gananoque will be trained and familiar with various assistive devices that may be used by our customers while accessing our goods and services. Employees will be able to help with the assistive devices upon request. Employees will always ask before assuming help is needed.

Availability of Assistive Devices

The Town provides several assistive measures on-site to enable people with disabilities to benefit from the same level of service, in the same place and in a similar way as other customers while accessing our goods and services.

Employees of the Town will be trained to know how to find and use all assistive devices available for customers within their functional departments.

The following assistive devices are available on our premises:

- Alternative format documents
- Automatic door openers (at various facilities as the Town achieves required compliance)
- Elevator (at various facilities as the Town achieves required compliance)
- Magnifying glasses
- Staff Assistance
