

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE

BYLAW NO. 2017-073

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES FOR THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL AND LOCAL BOARDS FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE.

WHEREAS Section 283 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended provides for the passing of by-laws for the paying of remuneration and expenses to members of Council and members of any local board of the municipality and of the officers and employees of the local board.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Gananoque did not revoke the resolution under subsection 255 (2) or (3) of the old Act before January 1, 2003, declaring that one third of the remuneration paid to the elected members of council is deemed as expenses incident to the discharge of their duties as members of the council;

AND WHEREAS under Section 283 (5) of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25*, such resolution shall be deemed to be a by-law of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS by Section 5 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 2 of Section 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, the powers of every Council are to be exercised by Bylaw; and

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2011, c. 25, section 8 (1)* provides in part that the powers of a municipality under the *Municipal Act* shall be interpreted to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque hereby enact as follows;

1. Effective January 1, 2019, an annual allowance shall be paid to each member of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque, as set out in Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
2. Such allowance shall be paid bi-weekly, and in the event of the death of a member or upon his/her ceasing to be a member for any reason before the expiration of his or her term of office, the amount payable to him/her or to his/her personal representative shall be in proportion to the period of his/her service during such term.
3. Effective January 1, 2019 annual honorariums shall be paid to each member of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque designated as a member of a Joint Service Committee, as set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto.
4. In accordance with Section 283 (5) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, that one-third of the amount payable to members of Council shall be deemed to be for expenses incident to the discharge of a members duties and therefore exempt from Income Tax.
5. That this by-law come into force and effect on the date of passing.
