Whereas there is an ever-growing amount of truck traffic that travels on these highways. There is also an ever-increasing amount of dangerous goods that are transported on those trucks;

Whereas it has been identified that high rates of speed during inclement weather events have contributed to accidents in our region including the recent accident that resulted in a chemical spill;
