APPLICATIONS FOR ROUND 4:

1. The 1000 Islands International Sidewalk Chalk Art Festival – Requesting 3,500.00 to help with their annual Festival.

Staff Recommendation – Decline as in the Town budget they have already received \$2,500.00, it is known where the funds will be allocated and it looks like they have budgeted for a deficit/loss. The committee discussed that this in the future should be under the council grants and it was a great event for the community.

Moved by: Councillor Jansen Seconded by: Jayne Curtis Be it resolved that the Community Grants Committee recommend to Council to approve the request for a Community Grant of \$3,500.00 from The 1000 Islands International Sidewalk Chalk Art Festival with a letter encouraging a larger organization and more sponsors.

2. Kingston School of Arts – Requesting 5,000.00 to help with their Kingston Prize gala at the Firehall Theatre which starts October 3, 2013. Funds will be allocated to the rental of the Firehall Theatre, supplies, labour and advertising.

Staff Recommendation – Approval and recommend that this be moved to Council Grants every two years starting in 2015. The Committee agreed that this event is great for the community.

Staff Recommendation– Approval as this is a one-time event and is a positive impact on local economy.

The second part of their application they are requesting \$5,458.00 to cover the cost of medals for the Timbits Ontario Provincial Elementary School Championships that they are hosting April 4, 2013.

Staff Recommendation – Approval as this is a one-time event and a positive impact on the local economy.
