WHEREAS THE LEEDS, GRENVILLE AND LANARK DISTRICT HEALTH UNIT
TODAY JOINED WITH THE CHAMPLAIN AND SOUTH EAST REGIONS'
HOSPITAL CHIEFS OF STAFF AND MEDICAL OFFICERS OF HEALTH TO
RELEASE A STATEMENT ABOUT THE STATUS OF COVID-19 IN THE AREA,

AND WHEREAS THE KEY MESSAGES INCLUDED:

- GET ALL COVID-19 VACCINES YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR, INCLUDING BOOSTER DOSES.
- 2. STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK EVEN IF YOUR SYMPTOMS ARE MILD.
- 3. IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS TAKE A RAPID ANTIGEN TEST (RAT) IF POSSIBLE, OR A PCR TEST IF ELIGIBLE.

7. IF YOU TEST POSITIVE OR HAVE SYMPTOMS, EVEN IF THEY ARE MILD, YOU SHOULD STAY HOME FOR AT LEAST FIVE DAYS <u>OR AS OTHERWISE ADVISED BY CURRENT ISOLATION GUIDANCE</u>. INDIVIDUALS CAN BE INFECTIOUS FOR UP TO 10 DAYS, SO IT IS IMPORTANT THAT FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE DAYS YOU WEAR A MASK WHEN OUTSIDE YOUR HOME AND AVOID THOSE WHO ARE MOST VULNERABLE AND HIGH-RISK SETTINGS LIKE HOSPITALS AND LONGTERM CARE.

ALL THE MEASURES COMBINED WILL HELP TO REDUCE OTHER RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS, INCLUDING INFLUENZA THAT IS CIRCULATING IN OUR COMMUNITY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GANANOQUE DIRECTS STAFF TO HOLD A VIRTUAL COUNCIL MEETING (AS OPPOSED TO IN PERSON) FOR APRIL 19, 2022
