5. Pine Street Reconstruction

- Paul McMunn, Manager of Public Works, presented a proposed new design concept, attached, and that should Council approve this concept to remove the multi-use pathway it would minimize the loss of various established trees on Pine Street.
- Paul noted that the proposed design, would remove approximately seven (7) trees. Four (4) are located directly on service lines and two (2) or three (3) are past their prime and for safety reasons, will be removed.
