Terry will look into both items.</li> <li>Doug and Mike will grab the Serviceberry tree from Montreal – this was scheduled for planting in 2017.</li> </ul>		
	(b) Maintenance for 2017 plantings. Water. Mulch?		
	<ul> <li>Town staff will add mulch in the spring and keep an eye on them should they require water.</li> <li>(c) Pruning and trimming plans for 2018. Use of in house or contractor.</li> <li>Peter and Doug will identify trees. Once the Town has an idea of the workload, they will</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>determine to outsource or not.</li> <li>(d) EAB TreeAzin treatment for 2018. Who? \$ Available?</li> <li>An RFQ was sent out and results will be discussed at the next committee meeting.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>(e) Arborist training course for town employee? Terry</li> <li>Doug and Peter will host a course in the spring and train employees. They will send materials to Terry and give him a few dates to work with.</li> </ul>		
	TRAILS:		
	<ul> <li>(a) Maintenance program for 2018. What and who?</li> <li>Town staff will maintain the same responsibilities as 2017 in regards to trail maintenance.</li> <li>A more detailed plan will be developed in the coming months.</li> <li>(b) New brochure with upgraded trail markers for location identification. New markers? Directional? Doug and Carl.</li> </ul>		
	• Ongoing. (c) Narrows Loop bench and table. Fix or abandon? Other location facilities such as benches, walkways, chip distribution?		
	<ul> <li>Staff will work towards providing natural benches that are carved from large trees, and are not as easy to throw into the water.</li> <li>No metal fixture replacements will be added.</li> </ul>		

	• The Town will look to rent a mini-loader to assist with the distribution of chips in the spring and fall.				
	(d) Any promotional activities for trails. Use of OTC facilities?				
	• Staff will look for a volunteer or co-op student that's good with video that can help promote the trail system.
