Trails Agenda

Letter to Council:

Members reiterated their support of the final draft which Peter will sign and forward to council.

Town request for 10 year capital requirements:

The committee voted to keep the \$25,000 in reserve. Also discussed and was recommended that \$10,000 to be allocated in future years for resurfacing the Lions trail section with stone dust.

2014 budget requirements for operation monies:

The current \$5000 allocated to Trails and Trees seems to work quite well with our needed cash flow. Further discussion will take place during January's planning meeting.

Jim's proposed work schedule for trails in 2014:

Jim's suggested schedule was reviewed and approved in principle. An additional 80 hours is to be allocated by Sue next year to trail maintenance.

Current budget status:

Peter reviewed the to-date expenditures and the committed dollars to suggest that all but \$1300 will be spent by January 2014.

Train bridge lookout...status:

Bill had been in contact with Bob and explained what was now required by the committee after last month's deliberations. Once we get the drawings we will submit same to council for their decision. Some resistance is expected due to the expense. Perhaps a community grant application is the way to go?

Planning meeting:

At this January 15th meeting we should discuss interpretive signs.

JCP trail work over the winter:

It was decided that no trail work is required by the JCP crew other than what is now scheduled.

Other business:

John suggested that a letter of thanks be sent to the local high school thanking the students and teachers for their cooperation and assistance.

Ash Tree inventory:

Council has the report and, although not approved until budget deliberations are complete, Sue has placed the first application dollars in her 2014 operation budget.

Memorial trees:

Rick complimented Doug on the great design and look of the current number of installed plaques; both memorial and tree identification. The dedication will take place in May. An article to the EMC and Reporter was discussed to get more families to dedicate a tree. Sending a notice out in the bills for the PUC was discussed.
