Challenges facing the Town which include housing affordability and availability Increase in demand for commercial lands and economic development inquiries - Staff proposing to amend boundaries of residential lands to employment lands and employment lands to residential Lands presently designated as employment lands are challenged due to the topographic nature of the properties The bulk of the lands in the Town are designated residential The new Official Plan will include an updated roads network map There will be an updated constraints map provided from the Ministry.
