GANANOQUE BUSKER APPLICATION

Definition: What is Busking

Busker a person or group of persons who plays musical instruments, sings, dances, acts or otherwise provides entertainment and who seek donations for such performances. This by-law **does not** include face painters, portrait artists, painters, crafts people, psychics or any person or artist who provides a service or produces a product.

1. The designated area for Buskers shall be located as follows:		
a.	. Town Park – Thursday Evenings 4:00pm – 6pm – Farmers Market	
b.	Town Park – anytime when it is not used by other groups /events/organizations	
C.	Waterfront - 125 Water Street, east of Historical Village buildings	
d.	Visitor Centre – 10 King St. front porch	

The permit holder agrees to comply with the following conditions:

2. Hours of operations shall be from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.

3. Buskers are required to move to another location every 2 hours

- 1. One street performance is permitted to be at one location only.
- 2. Buskers are permitted to use amplification no greater than 60 db or 18 watts.
- 3. The amplification system must be battery operated only.
- 4. No boom boxes, recorded or broadcast music is permitted.

- 5. Buskers are only permitted to sell recordings or original work **only** during the time of performance.
- 6. Buskers must in no way jeopardize the comfort and safety of others.
- 7. Buskers must respect the wishes of nearby residents and businesses.
- 8. Buskers and/or their audience may not block pedestrian flow or display windows or business entrances.
- 9. Buskers will cease any activity and remove performance equipment or materials which are located within the public street allowance at the request of a Gananoque Police Officer or By-law Enforcement Officer.
- 10. Buskers must ensure that no equipment, props, or other materials used are left unattended at any time.
- 11. Buskers must ensure that no aspect of the performance or any equipment or props used pose a danger or risk to the public.
- 12. Buskers should be courteous in their behaviour and tidy in presentation.
- 13. Signs, banners or displays that are not integral to the performance are not permitted.

The Town of Gananoque reserves the right to:

- 1. The Clerk may suspend the license to any or all buskers, for the following reasons:
 - a. the holding of special events
 - b. the construction, maintenance or repair of public highways;

- d. matters relating to pedestrian, vehicular or public safety or public health.
